



Footwear Style Guide

Girls Sixth Form

Unlike younger students, Sixth Form students may also wear shoes with minimal metal accessories which are part of the shoe design and not a fashion statement. Shoes with other distinctive fashion features, moccasins, training shoes and boots are not permitted. Stilettos and sharp-heeled shoes are not worn for health and safety reasons, and heels must be kept to less than 4 cm (measured where the heel meets the instep). All shoes must provide substantial foot support, therefore thin-soled ballet pumps are not allowed.



Footwear may be purchased from any retailer but must be plain black (including the sole), polishable, with minimal pattern.
